## **Turf Aftercare**

Moisture levels must be maintained while the grass is establishing.

Generally, each roil of turf needs a gallon of water per day, even if it does rain.

Do not mow until the turf has rooted down, you can check this by trying to lift a corner of a piece of turf and if it will not lift it is safe to mow.

Cut regularly using a mower that collects the clippings.

Please do not cut more than a quarter of the length whilst the turf is still getting established and gradually bring the height down over time.

If there are persistent dry conditions, before mowing, you can raise the height to the upper limit and leave the clippings to try and help retain moisture.
